Preface

Pursuant to the 2020-2021 General Appropriations Act, H.B.1, 86th Texas Legislature, Regular Session, 2019 (Rider 14(e), Other Reporting Requirements), the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) has reviewed fees for Fiscal Year 2020.

This manual compiles basic information about fee programs administered by DSHS during 2020. Figures in this report are based on FY20/AY20 for the period of September 01, 2019 through August 31, 2020. Information contained in this manual includes the date of origin, statutory authority, brief description of the fee, revenue history, and deposit coding information. Fringe benefits are included in the costs reported.

In compliance with Rider 14(e), Other Reporting Requirements, fee methodologies and projections have been added. A methodology is only included when a fee is changed. Additionally, a review of indirect costs was conducted and, for uniformity in reporting current year, some costs for prior years were changed and no longer match previous fee manual figures.

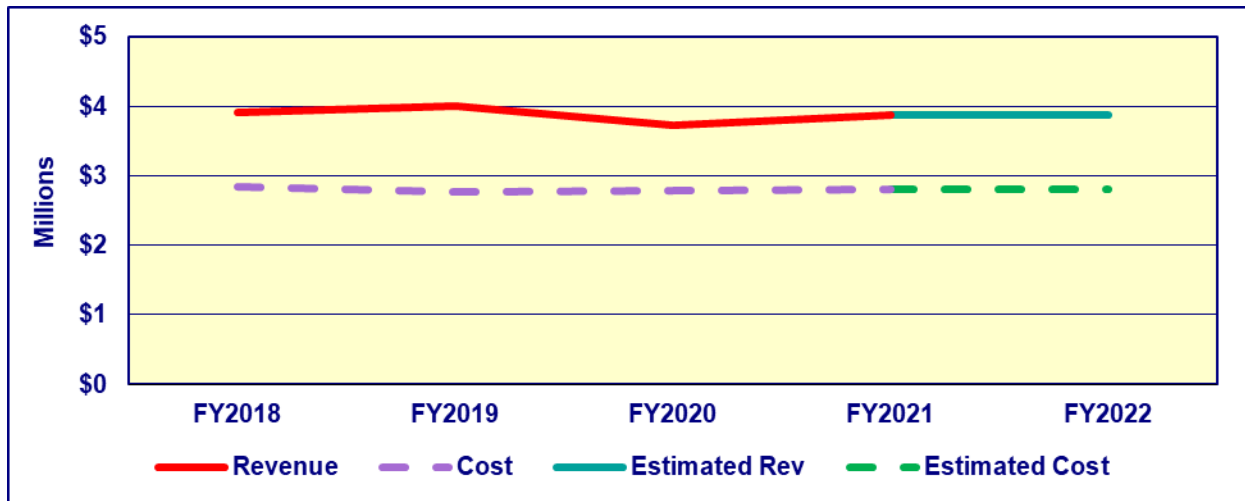

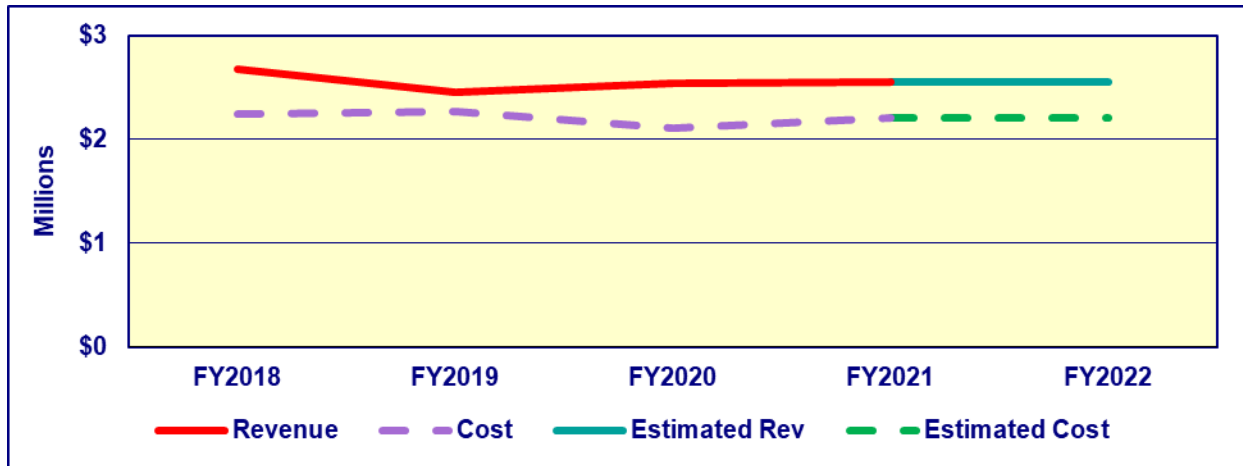

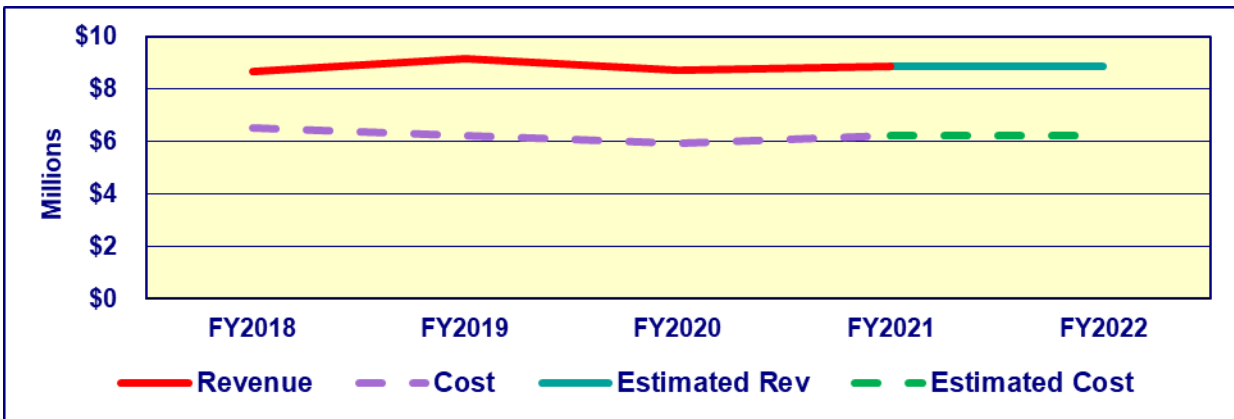

Food and Drug Wholesale Distribution/Manufacturing
