

PTE Growth Trends



In 2014, there were 57,062 actively licensed pharmacy technicians (PTE) providing care in Texas.

■ This number represents a 71.0% increase since 2009. With these improvements, Texas was at 98.0% of the PTE national average.


Geographic Distribution of PTEs

PTEs were not evenly distributed throughout the state.


- There was a 15.0% difference between the number of PTEs in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas the percent difference was 33.5%.
