




SOTP Growth Trends



In 2014, there were 526 actively licensed sex offender treatment providers (SOTP) providing care in Texas.

- This number represented an 18.7% increase since 2009 and an 40.6% increase since 2004.


Age Distribution of SOTPs

Within ten years, 50.0% of SOTPs will be at or approaching retirement age.

- 19.4% of SOTPs were eligible for retirement in 2014.
- 33.8% were between 41 and 55 years of age.
- 16.1% of SOTPs were 40 years of age or younger.

Geographic Distribution of SOTPs

SOTPs were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 1.3% difference between the number of SOTPs in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas the percent difference was 98.4%.
