Re: Illness Management and Recovery Technical Assistance Calls

In September 2013, the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) will initiate technical assistance calls to provide Local Mental Health Authorities (LMHAs) with guidance and support in the implementation of Illness Management and Recovery (IMR), an evidence-based psychosocial rehabilitation practice.

Background

In an effort to support evidence-based practices, DSHS offered four statewide live trainings in IMR during Fiscal Year (FY) 2013. Additionally, since July 2013, DSHS has made available an online certification course in IMR. Training in IMR was required in the FY 2013 contract. However, certification is not mandatory at this time.
