Re: Assertive Community Treatment Team Technical Assistance Calls

In September 2013, the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) will initiate technical assistance calls to provide Local Mental Health Authorities (LMHAs) with the latest information and support pertaining to Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) Team evidence-based practices.

Background

In an effort to support evidence-based practices, DSHS offered two live trainings on the ACT Team Model during fiscal year (FY) 2013. Training in this model was required in the FY 2013 contract. The DSHS sponsored training met this requirement, but was not the only source of acceptable training. DSHS offered these trainings in response to LMHA requests for training and guidance in the ACT Team model as well as ongoing efforts by DSHS to promote and support evidence-based practices.

As centers work to implement what they learned at the ACT Team trainings, DSHS will support these efforts with monthly technical assistance calls.
