**SUBJECT:** Adoption of Amendments to §412.202(b) of Chapter 412, Subchapter D  
(concerning Admission, Continuity, and Discharge) and repeal of Chapter 415,  
Subchapter J (concerning Preadmission `Screening and Resident Review  
(PASARR)

Effective May 24, 2013, the Department of State Health Services will adopt amendments to §412.202(b), concerning PASRR.

Notice of the proposed amendments to §412.202(b) and repeal of Chapter 415, Subchapter J, was published in the February 22, 2013, issue of the *Texas Register* for public review and comment. Comments were received from National Association of Social Workers - Texas Chapter, Austin; Disability Rights Texas, Austin; and MHMR Authority of Brazos Valley, Bryan during the public comment period. In April 2013, the Commissioner of the Health and Human Commission approved the adoption of the amendments to the subchapter with changes to the text as proposed. Notice of the adoption was published in the May 17, 2013, issue of the *Texas Register*.

  6. Click on "find" and the publication data will be available.
- Click on each section to access the rule text, the "preamble" explains changes to the rule, and the text of the sections being repealed.

### **What's different?**

The attached preamble and final rule text describe the amendments and repeals concerning the subchapter.

### **Reason for the New Subchapter**

The purpose of PASRR is to ensure that placement of the patient in a nursing facility is necessary, to identify alternate placement options when applicable, and to identify specialized services that may benefit the person with a diagnosis of mental illness, intellectual disability, or developmental disability. To promote a clear, consistent implementation of the PASRR Program, the Department of Aging and Disability Services (DADS), who is designated with the responsibility for administering the PASRR Program in Texas, is promulgating PASRR Program rules to which LMHAs and SMHFs must comply. The department is amending an applicable rule in Chapter 412, Subchapter D, §412.202, concerning admission, continuity, and discharge to require that LMHAs and SMHFs comply with federal regulations and the rules in 40 TAC Part 1, Chapter 17, concerning substantially the same matter.
