



Notes:

- *SAPT- Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant Provider
- *If Individual has other insurance coverage besides Medicaid, a referral should be made for that payor
- * Providers should monitor each individual's coverage/benefits (including Medicaid) on an ongoing basis.
- *If the individual becomes enrolled in Medicaid retroactive to a prior date, then any services that have been billed by provider to the SAPT Block Grant that are covered by Medicaid SUD benefit should be reversed in the DSHS system (CMBHS) and re-billed to Medicaid. Providers need to ensure that all individuals meet clinical criteria for the level of service provided. The HMOs are allowed to have separate administrative processes. In these retroactive cases, providers should work with the appropriate payor.
- *Ancillary Services for Woman's and Children's Residential and Pregnant Women are Specifically Covered in a separate Process Flow to be provided at a later time.
