***You cannot tell if an animal has rabies by looking at it.**

You can be exposed to rabies anywhere you encounter wildlife. It is good to enjoy nature, but you need to respect and understand it. Leave wild animals alone. Do not try to hand-feed them. Teach children to do the same.

Do not touch sick, injured, or dead animals. If you need help, call a local animal control officer, health department official, game warden, law enforcement officer, park employee, or rabies control authority.
