
Task Force of Border Health Officials Environmental Health Recommendations

- Improve capacity for mitigation and use innovative methods for mosquito control
- Create a Tire Abatement Task Force to reduce mosquito proliferation and mosquito-borne diseases
- Work with local leadership, councils of governments, Texas
 Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), and police departments
 to support enforcement efforts, ordinances and initiatives to improve
 public health
 - City ordinances require deposit fee of \$10 per tire:
 Laredo McAllen
 - City of Houston now partners with Houston Police Department:
 Can ticket drivers of vehicles with six tires or more
