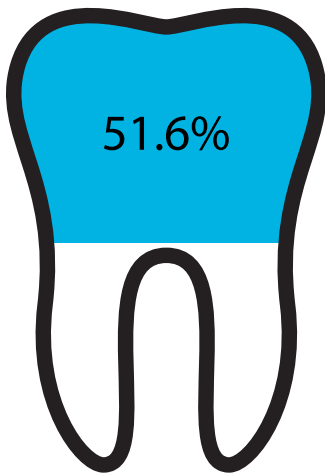

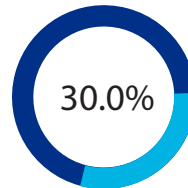

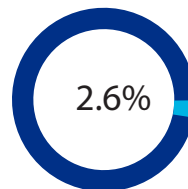
In a class of 25 Texas high school students, more than four (16.7%) of them missed school on at least one day in the past 12 months due to pain or soreness with their teeth or mouth.



More than half of Texas high school students reported their teeth or mouth had been sore or painful in the past 12 months.

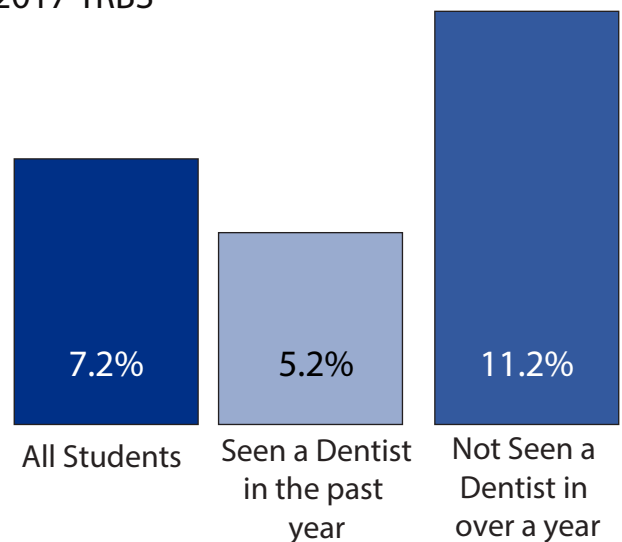


Almost 1 in 3 Texas high school students have not seen a dentist or dental hygienist in the past 12 months for any reason.



Nearly 1 in 33 Texas high school students have NEVER seen a dentist or dental hygienist for any reason.
