

Summary for IP vs OP vs ED Data

Inpatient Discharge Data

Beginning with January 1, 1999 discharges:

Collection of hospital inpatient discharges.

The Inpatient Discharge Data contains patient-level information for patients which are discharged by hospitals.

Outpatient Data

Beginning with October 1, 2009 services:

Collection of Outpatient services from hospitals and ambulatory surgery centers (ASC).

The outpatient data collection is limited to patients that receives one or more outpatient invasive/incisive surgical or one or more radiological/imaging procedures.

Beginning with January 1, 2015 visits:

Collection of hospital-based Emergency Department (ED) visits determined by revenue codes 0450-0459 (Emergency Department Revenue codes).

Beginning with October 1, 2020 visits:

Collection of Freestanding Emergency Medical Care Facilities (FEMCF) ED visits determined by revenue codes 0450-0459 (Emergency Department Revenue codes).

Emergency Department Data

The Emergency Department Data is a subset of the Inpatient Discharge and Outpatient Data Files determined by revenue codes 0450-0459 (Emergency Department Revenue codes).

Beginning with January 1, 2016 discharges and services:

Collection of hospital Inpatient Discharges on patients admitted into a hospital through an Emergency Department determined by revenue codes 0450-0459 (Emergency Department Revenue codes).

Collection of hospital-based ED visits determined by revenue codes 0450-0459 (Emergency Department Revenue codes).

Beginning with October 1, 2020 visits:

Collection of Freestanding Emergency Medical Care Facilities (FEMCF) ED visits determined by revenue codes 0450-0459 (Emergency Department Revenue codes).
