2.	Takes appropriate PPE precautions		
3.	Manually opens airway and inserts adjunct		
4.	Ventilates patient within 30 seconds at rate of 10-12/minute, sufficient volume to make chest rise		
5.	Preoxygenates and positions patient properly in preparation for intubation		
	Performs Intubation		
6.	Inserts laryngoscope device, without using teeth as fulcrum		
7.	Visualize glottis and inserts ET tube to proper depth		
8.	Inflates cuff to proper pressure and immediately removes syringe		
9.	Ventilates patient within 30 seconds of last breath		
10.	Confirms proper tube placement by auscultation bilaterally over lungs and over epigastrium		
11.	Secures ET tube		
12.	Ventilates patient at proper rate and volume while confirming capnography/capnometry		
13.	Steps 6-12 in sequence		
	Suctions secretions from tube		
14.	Recognizes need to suction		
15.	Identifies/selects flexible suction catheter		
16.	Inserts catheter into ET tube while leaving catheter port open		
17.	At proper insertion depth, covers catheter port and applies suction while withdrawing (less than 10 seconds)		
18.	Ventilates/directs ventilation of patient as catheter is flushed with sterile water		
19.	Reaffirms proper tube placement		
20.	Ventilates patient at proper rate and volume while confirming capnography/capnometry		
21.	At no time during skill were ventilations interrupted for greater than 30 seconds		
22.	Exhibits calm professional demeanor with all persons involved		
23.	Exhibits leadership and teamwork
