



TB Incidence Rate for Selected Geographic Areas Texas, 2014



Rates of Reported Tuberculosis Cases Texas Counties, 2014




Tuberculosis Rates

Racial Disparities in TB rates, 2014



Number of Drug Resistant TB Cases


Texas 2004-2014

TB Facts

- TB incidence increases with age, with the highest incidence in those between 55 and 64
- TB incidence higher in males than females
- Each year we identify approximately 2,600 TB infections through contact investigations
- Each year, an average of 57 cases have large contact investigations with more than 50 contacts identified
