

SAN Growth Trends



In 2014, there were 1,111 actively registered sanitarians (SAN) providing care in Texas.

- This number represented an 11.8% increase since 2009 and an 11.9% increase since 2004.



- Within ten years, 23.2% of active 2014 sanitarians for whom data were available will be at or approaching retirement age.
- In 2014, 58.3% of the actively registered sanitarian workforce for whom data were available was 45 years of age or younger.

¹ Age data were unavailable for 627 active Texas sanitarians.

Geographic Distribution of SANs

Sanitarians were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 44.6% difference between the number of sanitarians in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas the percent difference was 65.3%.
