1. Universal precautions assured before beginning procedures	*1*	
2. Avoids contamination of equipment or replaces contaminated equipment prior to use	*1*	
3. Confirms order (medication, dosage and route) (can be in protocols or online direction).	1	
4. Informs patient of order for medication and inquires about allergies and recent doses of other bronchodilators	1	
5. Selects correct medication from drug box as requested by Examiner (have at least 4 choices)	*1*

7. Adds appropriate volume of medication to the nebulizer	1
