- Motion to approve minutes by Garcia, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Farris, approved by all present
- Presentation by George Hatch and Debbie Cason on EMS education accreditation
  - CoAEMSP is sole organization that accredits EMS programs, 14 states already require program accreditation
  - EMS Agenda for the Future was impetus for accreditation leading to EMS Education Agenda for the Future, etc...
  - Only required for Paramedic education programs
  - Survey conducted by NREMT of paramedic education programs concerning knowledge, attitudes, and barriers to accreditation (National & Individual state)
  - January 01, 2013 is NREMT implementation date
  - The ability to award college credit is a necessity for accreditation
  - Extensive discussion ensued
  - Maxie Bishop stated that they will take the issue to the legislature for support
- Sought clarification from Maxie Bishop on the status of disciplinary rule changes – they will brief GETAC main body about response from lawyers and legislature
- Schedule of rule changes will become a standing document and will be listed as a resource document at every meeting

- Keri Grant is retiring from the committee and Larry Rascon from El Paso FD will be joining the group
- Lon Squyres addressed upcoming potential changes to narcotics regulations as they apply to EMS. We will discuss this at our next meeting on January 8, 2010 in Austin.
