	<b>Performance Improvement</b> <i>Participation in county or area child fatality review team.</i>	NC TRAC provided a presentation on Child Fatality Review teams. Our county has a low percent of pediatric deaths
36	<b>Performance Improvement</b>  <i>Review of all pediatric deaths / child abuse / neglect cases</i>	Performance improvement is done only on pedi. pts. that are trauma related, nothing specific of peds.  Child abuse and neglect cases are only checked to see if the appropriate agencies are notified.
	<b>Community Programs</b>	Neonatal Resuscitation classes are taught here.
