# **COVID-19 Vaccine Provider Webinar, June 17**<sup>th</sup> **Highlights**

#### **News & Updates**

- The U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA) authorized an extension of the shelf life for the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine **from 3 months to 4.5 months** when refrigerated at temperatures of 36°-46° F (2°-8° C). Expiry dates for the Janssen COVID-19 vaccine may be updated as data from ongoing stability studies become available. Therefore, no expiry date appears on the carton or vial. There are three different methods to check the expiration, which you can view <u>here</u>.
- DSHS has launched a <u>Social Media Toolkit</u> that features messages and graphics to help educate, encourage, and support providers and their community members in their decision to get vaccinated!

#### **Vaccine Administration Reporting and Reminders**

- You can access the <u>COVID-19 Vaccine Product Information Guide</u> online! The guide provides key
  information including product package dimensions and weight, minimum order quantities, product
  presentation, distribution method, storage information, ancillary kit information, and other
  information.
- Providers should take steps to educate patients about the importance of keeping their vaccination record cards. Remember to provide options to assist patients with keeping their vaccination records safe. Providers can print patient records from ImmTrac2.
