Year End Review: 2015

- ▶ Roughly 3.6 million records submitted
** preliminary number only – not for statistical use*
- ▶ NEMESIS V3.3.4 XML upload capable
- ▶ NTDB XML upload capable

- ▶ Maven accepts both ICD-9-CM & ICD-10-CM codes
 - No end date for ICD-9-CM codes
 - NTDB – ICD-10-CM inclusion criteria located in the 2014 NTDS Data Dictionary page iv & v.

 - NEMESIS – ICD-10-CM Definitions

- ▶ Registries Operations Support (ROS) Team
 - Adrian Conder
 - Tiffany Munoz
 - Rose Walker
 - Judy Whitfield
- ▶ 2015 Highlights
 - 1809 stakeholder requests completed
 - Increase of 74% compared to 2014
 - Average open to close time: 2.14 days
 - Decrease of 71% compared to 2014

A Look Ahead: 2016

- ▶ Legacy data set end date: 31 December 2016
- ▶ What does this mean?
 - EMS – Only collect NEMESIS V3.3.4 data
 - Hospitals – Only collect NTDB data
 - LTAC/Rehab – TBI & SCI data
 - JP/ME – TBI, SCI & submersion data
- ▶ Changes reflected in both file upload & web-data entry
- ▶ Texas Custom Questions may change slightly
