# Reporting Requirements:

## *Health and Safety Code ~ EMS*

- ▶ The Texas EMS & Trauma Registries was created based on the Texas Health and Safety code requirements.
- ▶ Texas Health and Safety Code
  - Title 9, Subtitle B, Chapter 773
- ▶ Explains the need for a reporting system for the EMS community

# Reporting Requirements:

## *Health and Safety Code ~ Physicians/JP/ME*

- ▶ Texas Health and Safety Code
  - Title 2, Subtitle D, Chapter 92
- ▶ Provides definitions, reportable injuries, rules and reporting requirements
- ▶ Explains the need for a reporting system for physicians, justice of the peace and medical examiners


# Reporting Requirements: *Texas Administrative Code (TAC)*

- ▶ TAC
  - Title 25, Part 1, Chapter 103
- ▶ Provides reporting requirements
  - EMS
  - Physicians
  - Justice of the Peace
  - Medical Examiner
- ▶ Physicians are grouped by entity type
  - Hospital
  - Rehab/LTAC

- EMS

- Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI)

- Spinal Cord Injury (SCI)

- Submersion (near and actual drowning)

- Other Traumatic Injuries

## 1 Portal

# Roles

- ▶ Entity
  - Account Manager
    - Manage assigned users
    - Monitor data submission
    - Input data
  - Users
    - Input data
- ▶ Third-Party
  - Input data on entity's behalf
  - Requires a Business Associate Agreement

# Data Submission: *Methods*

- ▶ Web-Data Entry
  - One record at a time
  - Intended for smaller entities
- ▶ File Upload
  - Several records at one time
  - Legacy (.txt)
    - End date: 31 Dec 16
  - XML
    - National Trauma Data Bank (NTDB)
    - National EMS Information System (NEMESIS)
