David Martinez serves as the Branch Manager for the Newborn Screening Case Management program which is responsible for follow-up of abnormal newborn screens for genetic disorders and hearing loss. Mr. Martinez successfully administered the expansion of the Newborn Screening Case Management/Follow-up program in 2006. Through the expansion, the program increased the panel of disorders requiring follow up from seven genetic disorders to 27 disorders.

Previously, Mr. Martinez managed programs for the Texas Workers' Compensation Commission. This included the Medical Quality Review program that is responsible for reviewing the quality of care provided to injured workers in the workers' compensation system. Mr. Martinez also managed the Medical Dispute Resolution program, designed to help medical providers seek resolution of disputes regarding the medical necessity of treatment provided, preauthorization disputes, and fee-related disputes in the workers compensation system. Mr. Martinez successfully implemented the use of Independent Review Organizations in the Medical Dispute Resolution program. Mr. Martinez has 17 years of state government experience.
