

Performance Incentives

This section describes the incentives associated with state outcome measures.

In consultation with NTBHA, DSHS will calculate performance twice per contract period at the end of each SFY. Total incentive value is \$400,000 per state fiscal year.

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1. Substance Use Disorder: Length of Stay

Measures how long individuals stay engaged in treatment, without a break in treatment (break in treatment is defined as 15 days without a claim paid).

Annual Performance Standard	Incentive
>=6.6% of individuals stay engaged in treatment for at least 90 days	\$15,000
>=7.2% of individuals stay engaged in treatment for at least 90 days	\$30,000
>=7.8% of individuals stay engaged in treatment for at least 90 days	\$55,000

2. Substance Use Disorder: Service Engagement

Measures the percentage of enrollees who receive at least one Substance Use Disorder (SUD) service within 90 days after identification of problem on assessment by mental health providers.

Annual Performance Standard	Incentive
>= 27.5% of clients receive a SUD service after identification	\$15,000
>= 30% of clients receive a SUD service after identification	\$30,000
>= 32.5% of clients receive a SUD service after identification	\$55,000

3. Mental Health: Acute Services Child/Adolescent

Measures percentage of enrollees with an authorized Mental Health Level of Care who receive acute services relative to all enrollees with a LOCA. Acute services include ER, 23 hour observation and inpatient services.

Annual Performance Standard	Incentive
<0.4% of child/adolescent enrollees in RDM service package 1.1 receive an acute service within the month	\$20,000
<1.6% of child/adolescent enrollees in RDM service package 1.2 receive an acute service within the month	\$20,000
<2.5% of child/adolescent enrollees in RDM service package 2.2 receive an acute service within the month	\$20,000
<5.9% of child/adolescent enrollees in RDM service package 2.3 receive an acute service within the month	\$20,000
<4.1% of child/adolescent enrollees in RDM service package 2.4 receive an acute service within the month	\$20,000
<0.4% of child/adolescent enrollees in RDM service package 4 receive an acute service within the month	\$20,000

4. Mental Health: Acute Services: Adult

Measures percentage of enrollees with an authorized Mental Health Level of Care who receive acute services relative to all enrollees with a LOCA. Acute services include ER, 23 hour observation and inpatient services.

Annual Performance Standard	Incentive
<1.1% of adult enrollees in RDM service package 1 receive an acute service within the month	\$20,000
<1.9% of adult enrollees in RDM service package 2 receive an acute service within the month	\$20,000
<2.7% of adult enrollees in RDM service package 3 receive an acute service within the month	\$20,000
<5.4% of adult enrollees in RDM service package 4 receive an acute service within the month	\$20,000
