


Infectious Disease Reporting* in Health Service Region 11 for Health Care Providers



- Immediately reportable** infectious diseases:
- Anthrax
 - Botulism, foodborne
 - Diphtheria
 - Haemophilus influenzae* type b infections, invasive
 - Measles (rubeola)
 - Meningococcal infections, invasive
 - Plague (*Yersinia pestis*)
 - Poliomyelitis, acute paralytic
 - Rabies, human
 - Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS)
 - Smallpox
 - Staphylococcus aureus*, vancomycin-resistant (VISA and VRSA)
 - Tularemia
 - Viral hemorrhagic fever
 - Yellow fever
- Outbreaks, exotic diseases, or unusual group expressions of disease

- Conditions reportable **within one week:**
- Acquired Immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS)
 - Amebiasis
 - Arbovirus infection
 - Botulism, infant, wound and other
 - Campylobacteriosis
 - Chancroid
 - Chickenpox (varicella)
 - Chlamydia trachomatis* infection
 - Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease
 - Cryptosporidiosis
 - Cyclosporiasis
 - Cysticercosis
 - Dengue
 - Ehrlichiosis
 - Encephalitis (specify etiology)
 - Escherichia coli*, enterohemorrhagic
 - Gonorrhea
 - Hansen's disease (leprosy)
 - Hantavirus infection
 - Hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS)
 - Hepatitis B, C, D, E, and unspecified (acute)
 - Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) infection
 - Influenza-associated pediatric mortality
 - Legionellosis
 - Leishmaniasis
 - Listeriosis
 - Lyme disease
 - Malaria
 - Meningitis (specify type)
 - Mumps
 - Relapsing fever
 - Salmonellosis, including typhoid fever
 - Shigellosis
 - Spotted fever group rickettsioses
 - Streptococcal disease (group A, B, *S. pneumoniae*), invasive
 - Syphilis
 - Taenia solium* and undifferentiated *Taenia* infection
 - Tetanus
 - Trichinosis
 - Typhus
 - West Nile Fever
 - Yersiniosis
