Health and community education; immunizations for eligible children and adults; tuberculosis treatment and contact identification; HIV and STD testing, treatment or referral, and education; communicable disease investigations; emergency preparedness and response; general sanitation and food establishment inspections.

## Region 8 Activities

- Serve on COVID-19 monitoring team to assess cases
- As a member of the COVID-19 School Task Force, answer questions from area schools and the public
- Host annual flu vaccine clinic in partnership with Walgreens
- Serve on South East Region Child Fatality Review Team, the Community Resource Coordination Group, Golden Crescent Area Agency on Aging and Disability, the Health South Texas committee, Golden Crescent Traffic and Safety Coalition and the Golden Crescent Healthcare Coalition
- Provide health and safety programs, and information to the community
- Recruit and educate Texas Vaccines for Children providers
- Audit local schools and child care centers for compliance with immunization requirements
- Link individuals to health resources

## Immunizations

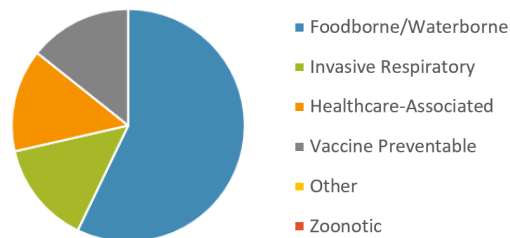
- The percent of school students with a conscientious exemption from immunizations filed at the school district level in Goliad County is 2.56% up from 0.63% in 2019

## 2020 Public Health by the Numbers

- 208 confirmed cases of COVID-19
- 27.16 COVID-19 incidence (Incidence is calculated using confirmed case counts reported on the DSHS dashboard; calculated per 1,000 population)
- 1 general sanitation inspection
- 3 school cafeterias inspected
- 45 clients received case management services through the Specialized Health and Social Services program
- 1 rabies quarantine facility inspected
- 121 dental evaluations for low-income children
- 112 fluoride treatments for low-income children
- 96 dental sealants applied for low-income children
