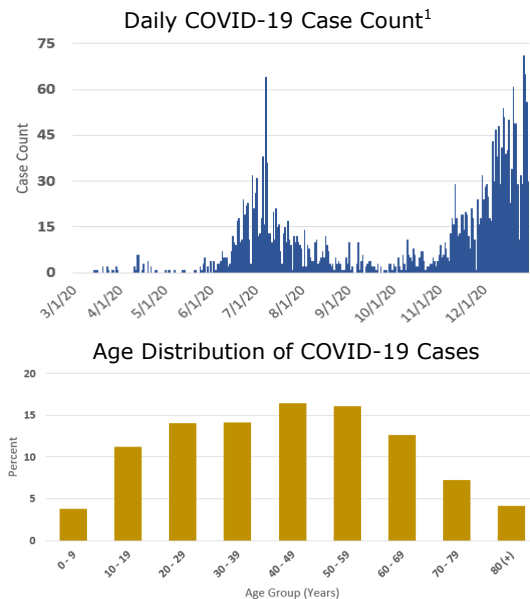
## Region 8 Activities

- Respond to the COVID-19 pandemic
- Serve on Poth, Floresville, La Vernia and Stockdale ISD School Health Advisory Councils (SHACs)
- Educate the community about prevention methods for child vehicular heatstroke deaths
- Participate on the Wilson County Interagency Council
- Serve on the Bexar County Child Fatality Review Team, which reviews child deaths in Wilson County
- Promote the use of ImmTrac2, the Texas Immunization Registry for children and adults
- Recruit and educate Texas Vaccines for Children providers
- Audit local schools and child care providers for compliance with immunization requirements
- Conduct healthcare provider visits, distribute resources, and educate providers on notifiable conditions and reporting

## Immunizations

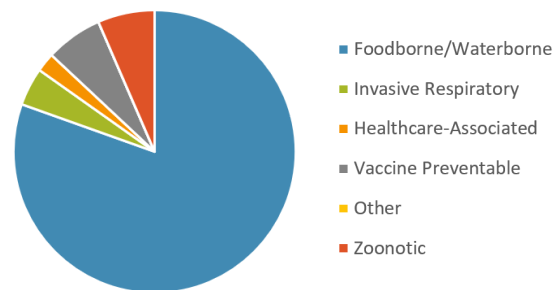
- The percent of school students with a conscientious exemption from immunizations filed at the school district level in Wilson County is 1.78% up from 1.54% in 2019

## 2020 Public Health by the Numbers

- 1,691 confirmed cases of COVID-19
- 33.11 COVID-19 incidence (Incidence is calculated using confirmed case counts reported on the DSHS dashboard; calculated per 1,000 population)
- 135 clients received case management services through the Specialized Health and Social Services program
- 2 rabies investigations conducted
- 2 rabies positive animals found
