

Health Service Region 8 Influenza Activity Report MMWR Week 21 Week Ending 05/26/2017

This report covers flu surveillance activities for the 28 counties that comprise Health Service Region 8: Atascosa, Bandera, Bexar, Calhoun, Comal, De Witt, Dimmit, Edwards, Frio, Gillespie, Goliad, Gonzales, Guadalupe, Jackson, Karnes, Kendall, Kerr, Kinney, La Salle, Lavaca, Maverick, Medina, Real, Uvalde, Val Verde, Victoria, Wilson, and Zavala.

Flu Activity

- 18 counties submitted reports this week.
- 4 counties reported no activity.
- 6 counties reported ILI activity only.
- 7 counties reported flu by rapid test.
- 1 county reported flu confirmed by PCR.
- In Region 8, activity in week 18 was about the same as week 18.

Summary

Influenza (flu) activity has decreased the past few months in Texas; it appears to have peaked in mid-February. Compared to the previous week, the percentage of specimens testing positive for influenza reported by hospital and public health laboratories and patient visits due to influenza-like illness (ILI) slightly decreased. In addition to flu, other respiratory viruses—especially rhino/enteroviruses—were detected in Texas during week 21.
