FISH AND SHELLFISH CONSUMPTION ADVISORY

ADV-50

This advisory is issued as a result of sampling of the Galveston Bay Estuary located in Brazoria, Chambers, Galveston, and Harris Counties, Texas. Blue crab and fish samples collected from the estuary indicate the presence of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) and polychlorinated dibenzo-p-dioxins and dibenzofurans (PCDDs/PCDFs) at concentrations exceeding health assessment guidelines established by the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). Consumption of blue crab, catfish, and spotted seatrout from the Galveston Bay Estuary may pose a threat to human health.

COUNTIES: Brazoria, Chambers, Galveston, and Harris


AREA: Upper Galveston Bay and all contiguous waters north of a line from Red Bluff Point to Five-Mile Cut Marker to Houston Point (**Map 1**)

AREA: Galveston Bay and all contiguous waters including Chocolate Bay, East Bay, Trinity Bay, and West Bay (**Map 2**)
