

This advisory is issued as a result of sampling of Lake Como, Tarrant County. Common carp samples collected from Lake Como indicate the presence of dieldrin, polychlorinated dibenzo-p-dioxins and dibenzofurans (PCDDs/PCDFs or dioxins), and polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) at concentrations exceeding health assessment guidelines established by the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). Consumption of common carp from Lake Como may pose a threat to human health.

COUNTY: Tarrant
AREA: Lake Como
SPECIES AFFECTED: Common carp
CONSUMPTION ADVISORY: People should not consume common carp from these waters.

This advisory shall remain in effect until rescinded or modified in writing.
