- **Public Health and Prevention Specialist I or II**
 - Provide education to the community on preventing chronic disease
- **Program Specialist I or II**
 - Conduct coalition building and program planning work for a DSHS initiative
- **Community Health Specialist**
 - Identify health care needs in a community and provide education
- **Customer Service Representative**
 - Communicate with partners regarding a DSHS service (e.g., Vital Statistics, Immunization Information Services) and keep records related to this program
