

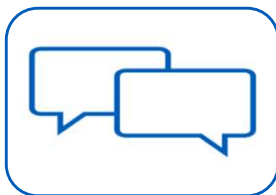

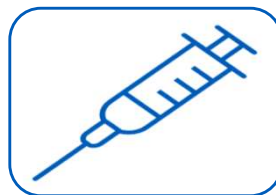

Examples of Entry Level Jobs in Community Health Work

Community Health Specialist

- Performs responsible technical, clerical and program administrative duties as a team with the public health nurse to maintain clinic flow and function according to DSHS policy and procedures.
- Assists with home visits and provides TB Direct Observation Therapy under nurse regional and TB program over site.
- Provides education to the community on various Title V Child and Maternal Health State or Federal performance measures targeted for data collection.

Community Engagement Liaison

- Performs administrative and technical assistance work to coordinate meetings, grant reporting, and communication.
- Work involves planning, developing and implementing vaccine initiatives, including COVID-19 Initiatives, and providing consultative services and technical assistance related to communication and outreach needs.

Social Worker

- Provides case management consultation for families with children who have health risks, conditions or special health care needs.
- Travels to conduct home visits, completes intakes, Family Needs Assessments, Service Plans, and Follow-up Services to families on caseload. Links families to community resources.
