Examples of Entry Level Jobs in Immunizations

Program Specialist I

- Respond to requests and inquiries from schools, health care providers, health departments, and the public about vaccine requirements and recommendations.
- Review data and update rules, policies, and procedures relating to vaccines.

Public Health and Prevention Specialist I

- Identify and prioritize tasks to improve vaccination coverage rates.
- Perform administrative work to support immunization clinic registration, community resource databases, the creation of educational materials, and community disaster response.

Epidemiologist II

- Perform investigative and consultative epidemiological work for respiratory infectious diseases.
- Plan, develop, initiate, and conduct studies and surveys to determine influenza vaccination uptake and coverage levels.

Interested in next steps? Consider gaining experience with health policy, education, and communication. Some positions with medical or nursing capacities will require licenses as a Medical Assistant, Vocational Nurse, and BLS/CPR.
