Examples of Entry Level Jobs in Information Technology

Systems Analyst IV

- Oversees and implements systems and procedures for complex HIV data systems.
- Supports and performs the planning, testing, administration, operation and maintenance of databases.
- Responsible for extensive end-user training and ensuring end-user confidence and acceptance of the system, workflow and report design, technical assistance, and managing program help desk requests.

Research Specialist

- Provides expert technical assistance on the Texas Immunization Registry.
- Provides support to DSHS programs and other internal and external entities submitting data to the registry.

Program Specialist

- Performs moderately complex consultative services, technical assistance, and research support in the Immunization Section.
- Collects, organizes, analyzes, and prepares materials in response to requests for school and child-care data.
