## Fellowship Overview

### Host Site Mission

The primary goal in Hays County is to ensure every resident achieves optimal health. The fellow will work to expand the Healthy Hays Coalition's infrastructure, with primary objectives including maintaining regular meetings, increasing participant numbers, identifying underserved areas, and finding ways to improve community investment and involvement.

### Fellowship Projects

As part of a fellowship with the Hays County Health Department, the fellow will work with the Healthy Hays Coalition. The Healthy Hays Coalition is a collaboration of stakeholders within the Hays County community that addresses five concerns (Mental Health, Immunizations, STIs, Social Services, and Health Indicators), which focus on developing strategies and interventions utilizing sustainable resources to improve health outcomes and overall well-being.

### Fellowship Deliverables

- Finalizing specific goals of each Healthy Hays Coalition workgroup
- Ensuring retention of at least 80% of the Healthy Hays Coalition members within 3-month periods
- Addressing various identified issues in our Community Health Assessment by implementing strategies outlined in our Community Health Improvement Plan

### Fellowship Activities/Responsibilities

In this role, the Hays County Health Department fellow will be responsible for effectively organizing the Healthy Hays Coalition workgroup meetings. Tasks will involve engaging with workgroup chairs to ensure productive collaboration and progress. Additionally, the fellow will develop detailed communication and marketing materials for the coalition and spearhead various promotional initiatives to increase community engagement and address behaviors that impact the public health. Furthermore, an aspect of the role will be actively recruiting and retaining members of the Healthy Hays Coalition, requiring a strategic approach to relationship-building. Lastly, the fellow will be responsible for creating detailed timelines and deliverables that are closely aligned with the objectives of the Hays County Community Health Improvement Plan, ensuring that all activities and initiatives contribute to the coalition's overall goals.
