Host Site Mission

The Public Health Preparedness & Epidemiology program works with local partners and stakeholders to plan, train, and exercise before a disaster response. The program provides regional public health and medical resources coordination during emergencies. The program offers training and guidance on preparedness, epidemiology, and public health emergency response.

Fellowship Projects

The primary project will be to conduct an analysis of After-Action Reports (AARs) and Improvement Plans (IPs) from past responses and exercises to assess the status of public health implementation of recommendations.

Fellowship Deliverables

- Create a spreadsheet or report outlining findings of the AARs and Improvement Plans (IPs) analysis.
- Update and use regional tracking tool for previous and future AARs and IPs.
- Public Health Preparedness Exercise using Incident Command System and Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP) methods.
- Final oral presentations to leadership and a summary describing experiences in each regional program.

Fellowship Activities/Responsibilities

The fellow will be responsible for setting meetings with team members and supervisor to complete projects. With direction from program leadership, the fellow will conduct an analysis of AARs and IPs from past responses and exercises to assess the status of public health implementation of recommendations and identify and categorize common themes, priority actions, and complexity. The fellow will study and apply the FEMA Incident Command System to public health practice. The fellow may assist with assessment of, planning for, and training for priority capabilities from the CDC Public Health Emergency Preparedness and Response Capabilities. In addition to the preparedness activities, the fellow will rotate through all PHR 7 programs. The rotation length will vary based on program complexity and fellow's interests.
