Vaccine Choice Opening February 8

Beginning Monday, Feb. 8, providers may update vaccine choice(s) through the Electronic Vaccine Inventory (EVI) system. In EVI, the "Update Choice" tab will be open at 10 a.m. on Feb. 8 and **close at 3 p.m. on Feb. 19**.

The next opportunity for providers to update their vaccine choice(s) will be May 2021.
