Dear Texas Vaccines for Children (TVFC) Program Provider,

The Texas Vaccines for Children (TVFC) and Adult Safety Net (ASN) Program policy states that if a multi-dose vial (MDV) has been opened or accessed (e.g., needle-punctured), the vial should be dated and discarded within 28 days unless the manufacturer specifies a different (shorter or longer) date for that opened vial.

In line with the TVFC Program and manufacturer policy, MDVs of IPOL® (Poliovirus Vaccine Inactivated) that have been opened or accessed **can be used until the expiration date printed on the vial or package insert** unless the vaccine is contaminated or compromised in some way.
