Note: Human mortality from arboviral conditions is aggregated and reported monthly once documentation has been received and verified.

Figure 1. Texas Counties Reporting Arbovirus Activity, Week 25




Figure 2. WNV-Positive Mosquito Pools Reported in Texas, by MMWR Week of Collection, 2022-2024, Week 25 **WNV-Positive Pools**80
