Immunization Updates



- Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV)
 - **Beyfortus™** (**Nirsevimab**) RSV immunization for infants has been available for ordering since October 2, 2023.
 - Due to limited national supply, nirsevimab was available for ordering in biweekly iterations from October 13 to January 31.
 - Nirsevimab returned to standard open ordering on Monday February 12, 2023, and will continue until supplies are depleted.
 - Abrysvo[™] (RSVpreF) RSV vaccine for maternal patients
 - Available for ordering December 20, 2023, to January 17, 2023.
 - Offered in the TVFC program for eligible pregnant people 18 and under.
 - ACIP-recommended only through January 31 for the 2023-2024 RSV season

• Influenza


- 2023-2024 flu vaccines are available for ordering as needed
- 2024-2025 flu prebooking closed February 2, 2024.
 - Prebooked doses will begin shipping closer to the 2024-2025 season

· COVID-19

No barriers or issues; distribution and ordering have faced no supply constraints
