
Trends, Distribution, and Demographics

2019




In 2019, there were 1,247 actively licensed audiologists in Texas.

- This number represented a 13.7% increase since 2014 and a 32.2% increase since 2009.
- Relative to population growth, the size of the audiologist workforce has improved by 11.2% over the past 10 years.
- Despite these improvements, Texas still has fewer audiologists than the national average

Within ten years, 24.2% of audiologists will be at or past retirement age.

■ 31.8% of audiologists were between 41 and 55 years of age in 2019

Audiologists were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 91.4% difference between the number of audiologists in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas, the percent difference was 118.8%.
