



YRBS Data Brief Suicide

Texas Youth Risk Behavior Survey 2019

Nearly one-fifth of all Texas high school students seriously considered suicide in the past 12 months.




Nearly one-third of students who had experienced sexual or physical violence attempted suicide.




Attempted suicides were twice as high among students with physical disabilities, or long term illness, compared to those without.



Three times as many students who identified as lesbian, gay, or bisexual attempted suicide compared to those who identified as straight.



Twice as many female students seriously considered suicide compared to male students.
