- Executive Order No. RP-79
 - Issued October 6, 2014
- House Bill 2950
 - Effective June 19, 2015





- Advisory panel to Governor
- Members appointed by Governor





- Recommendations for response to infectious diseases
 - Health and Safety Code, § 81.403(b)(1)
- Reliable and <u>transparent</u> source of information for Texas
 - Health and Safety Code, § 81.403(b)(2)





- Open Meetings Act
 - Government Code, Chapter 551
- Public Information Act
 - Government Code, Chapter 552
- Specific language in HB 2950
 - Health and Safety Code, § 81.406





- Notice required
- Must have quorum
- May meet via telephone





- Must stick to agenda
- May hold public hearings
- Must try to meet in various parts of Texas





- Matters confidential by law
- Public security or law enforcement needs
- Otherwise comply with Act



- Any information relating to the task force is public
- Exceptions to disclosure apply



Public Information Act

- Request triggers deadlines
- Penalties for ignoring

 - One time only
 - Within 90 days of appointment

Open Government Training

- Open meetings training
 - Required
- Open records training
 - May delegate
