# **Injury Severity Score (ISS) Data Entry for State Registry**

# **ISS History and Definition**

- Dates back to the 1970s
- Indicates overall severity of traumatic injuries
- Global scoring system
- Calculated by assigning Abbreviated Injury Scores (AIS) and taking the three highest body region scores and squaring them

(Association for the Advancement of Automotive Medicine, 2008)

## National and State Requirements

- The American College of Surgeons (ACS, 2021) requires the entry and submission of AIS Scores
- The State of Texas Trauma Registry follows the National Trauma Data Standard Data Dictionary for data entry and submission

• National Trauma Data Standards taken from the 2022 Dictionary (ACS, 2021):

#### AIS CODE

#### DESCRIPTION

The Abbreviated Injury Scale (AIS) code(s) that reflect the patient's injuries.

#### **ELEMENT VALUES**

• The code is the 8-digit AIS code.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION None

### Problem

- The State of Texas Trauma Registry is receiving files via file submission and via direct Maven data entry without AIS scores.
- The AIS score is not a required data entry field for direct Maven submission.
- Without AIS scores, the ISS is missing and cannot be calculated.

#### Data Submission: How does your center submit?

Statistics as of September 2022:

- 183 Level III and Level IV trauma centers submitted data in 2022
- 75 Web-data Entry (MAVEN)
  - 1 Level III (2.4%)
  - 74 Level IV (52.5%)
- 108 File Upload
  - 41 Level III (97.6%)
  - 67 Level IV (47.5%)

### Solution

#### For file submission:

- Run a report out of your facility's trauma registry prior to submission
- Validate that a correct and accurate ISS score is present for each patient record

#### For direct-web entry via Maven:

• Follow the steps on the next slides.
