# Definition of

## Hazard Communication Worker Right-to-Know (Hazcom)

Hazard Communication Worker Right-to-Know (Hazcom) means: the health and safety of persons working in this state may be improved by providing access to information regarding hazardous chemicals to which those persons may be exposed during normal employment activities, during emergency situations, or as a result of proximity to the manufacture or use of those chemicals.
