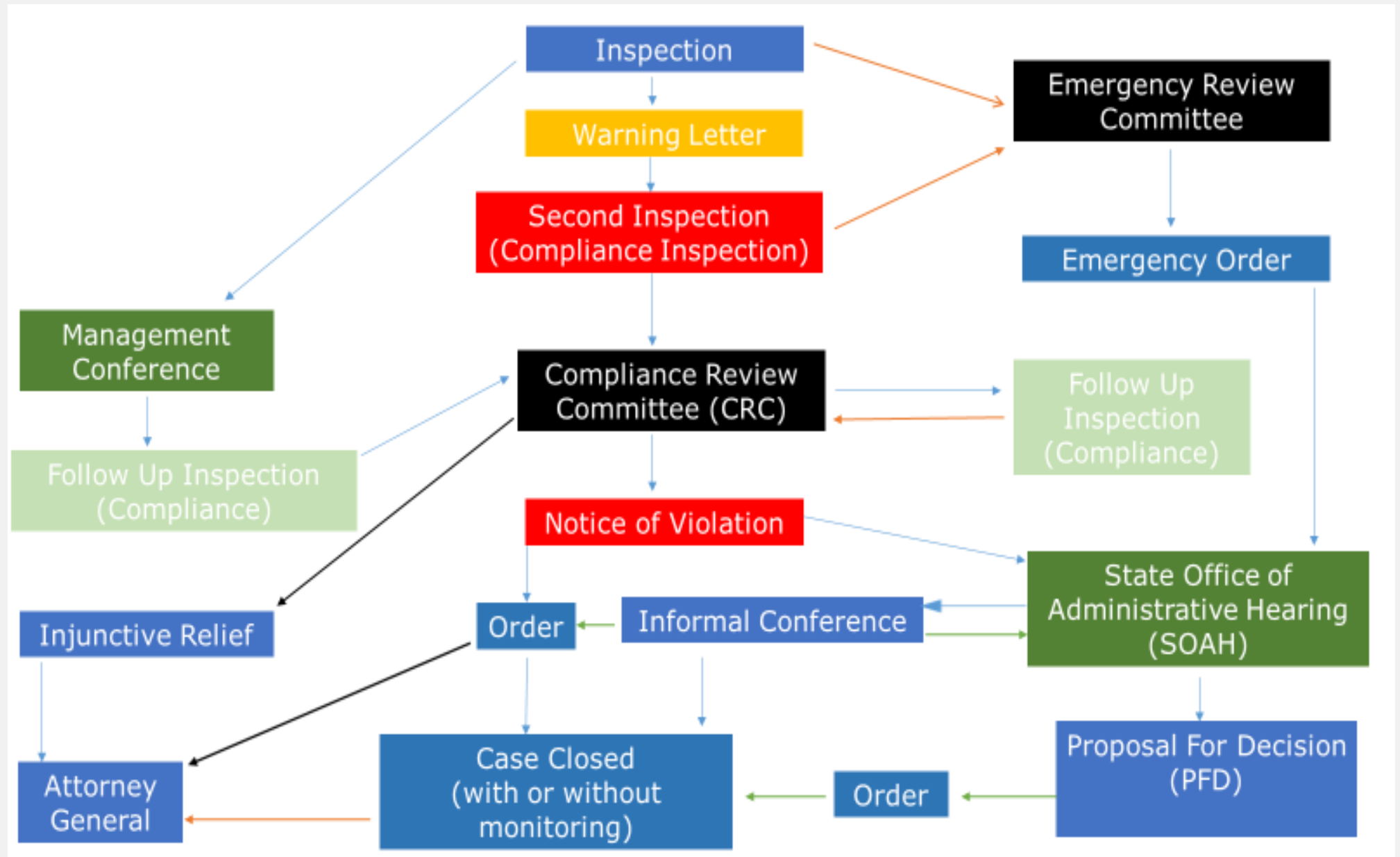


# **RADIATION CONTROL PROGRAM LICENSE AND REGISTRATION TYPES**
