Samples of fish and blue crabs collected from Clear Creek in Harris, Brazoria, and Galveston

Counties, which is covered by ADV-7 issued November 18, 1993, indicate that concentrations of

contaminants have decreased to acceptable levels. Consumption of fish and blue crabs from Clear

Creek upstream and west of Texas Highway 3 no longer poses a threat to human health.

ADV-7 for Clear Creek is hereby rescinded.

This advisory shall remain in effect until rescinded or modified in writing.
