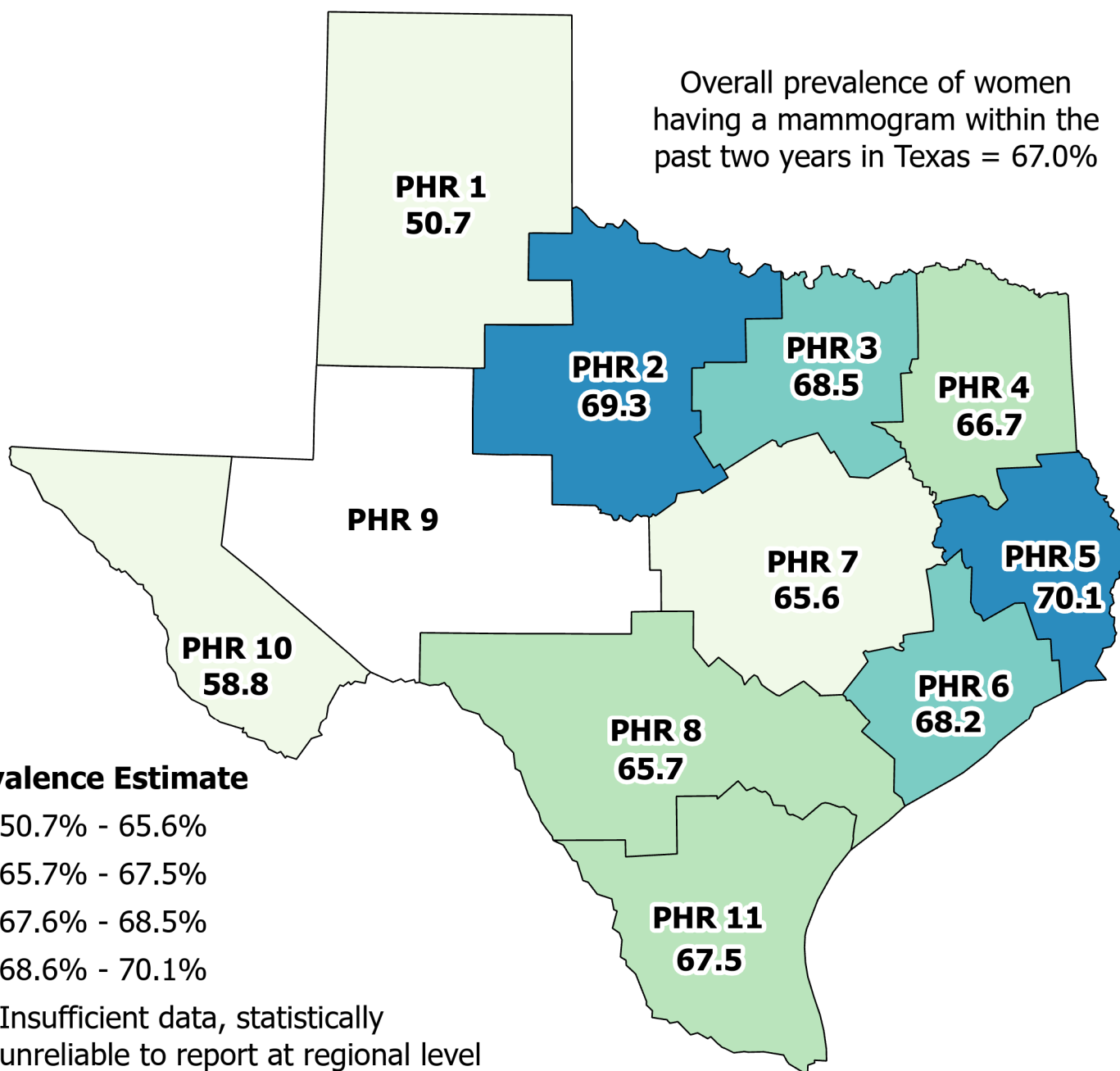


# Prevalence of Women, Aged 40 or Older, Who Have Had a Mammogram Within the Past Two Years By Public Health Region (PHR), Texas, 2022

Overall prevalence of women having a mammogram within the past two years in Texas = 67.0%



## Prevalence Estimate

- 50.7% - 65.6%
- 65.7% - 67.5%
- 67.6% - 68.5%
- 68.6% - 70.1%
- Insufficient data, statistically unreliable to report at regional level

**Data Classification:** Quantiles

**Data Source:** 2022 Texas Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Center for Health Statistics, Texas Department of State Health Service

Mammogram within the past two years among women, 40 or older, is defined as: "Yes" responses to the survey question, "Have you ever had a mammogram" and responses of "Within the past year" or "Within the past 2 years" to the question, "How long has it been since you had your last mammogram?" among women who reported their age to be 40 years or older.



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
