


2014 Texas Selected Cancer Facts

Tarrant County



These data are used to measure the Texas cancer burden, progress in cancer prevention and control, and support a wide variety of cancer research.




Tarrant County

In 2014, it is estimated that there will be 8,023 new cancer cases and 2,962 cancer deaths in Tarrant County.

Leukemia (ICCC* Group I)	245	25.6%
Brain/Central Nervous System (III)	222	23.2%
Lymphoma (II)	119	12.4%
All Other Groups	371	38.8%
