

TX population covered by smoke-free restaurants	47%
TX population covered by smoke-free bars in restaurants	44%
TX population covered by smoke-free bars not in restaurants	36%

# of TX municipal ordinances passed in 2007 4/17 (23%) were SF in all 5 settings; 9/17 (52%) SF in 3 or more settings	17


Protection level of all Texas municipalities with SHS ordinances in 2008 (n=259)

#/% cities with smoke-free bars not in restaurants	23/259: 9%


Percentage of the Texas Municipal Population Protected by 100% Smoke-Free Ordinances in all Five Settings*
