WIC Adjusts Not to Exceed (NTE) Egg Price

Due to continued increases in the price of eggs, the WIC State Office is raising the “not to exceed price” (NTE) for one dozen eggs from \$2.81 to \$3.51.

Food Item	Quantity	Old NTE	New NTE
Eggs – A or AA Large/Med/Small (No brown/no fertile)	1 Doz.	\$2.81	\$3.51

The new NTE price for eggs will have been downloaded to your electronic cash register system via the Approved Product Listing (APL) beginning May 29, 2015, when your system connects to the State EBT host. The new NTE for eggs will apply to all EBT transactions occurring in your lanes on or after May 29, 2015.

IMPORTANT: As a result of these changes, it is critical each retail outlet electronically connect to the State EBT host and download an updated Approved Product List (APL) after 1:00 am local time on May 29, 2015, before your store opens that day. If your store is open 24 hours, your ECR system should connect to the State host as soon as possible after 1:00 am on May 29, 2015, in order to process WIC transactions accurately.
